Administrative personnel will be in our school offices the week of March 23-27 and plan on returning to offices on April 20th. Because of the building being closed and to aid in the cleaning and safety of our building, all offices in the high school will be closed March 30th through April 19th.

Here are some points that are unique to high school and our operation:

- **Graduation:** At the time of this writing, graduation is still scheduled for May 31st at HNHS. We will have our graduation ceremonies on this day if at ALL possible; if it is determined that we can't have it on that date, we will look at alternative plans as needed and communicate those plans as soon as possible.
- **Prom:** High school is a time of unique experiences, one of those being the high school prom. Prom was scheduled for May 2nd; due to our mandated closing through May 1st, prom will not be held on the planned date. We understand the significance of prom, and as such will make absolutely every consideration and effort to have prom in some form at a later date if at all possible. We will be working with school personnel, community members, and the post-prom committee to work on how to best make prom a special event for our students.
- **CTE Programming:** Our CTE program director, Mrs. Tiffanney Drummond, has been actively monitoring the continually changing environment in regards to certification and testing. Mrs. Drummond will be in touch with all individuals who this information pertains to.
- **AP/Dual Credit Classes:** We are working with both national organizations and universities as they plan on how to best serve our students in these areas.
- **State Testing:** All state/standardized testing for this year has been cancelled.
- **Wifi Access:** There will continue to be Wifi access in the parking lot of HNHS and all other schools in our corporation, for those of you who have limited access to Wifi at home.

Once again, thank you for your hard work and dedication in helping us work through this unprecedented challenge. We are honored to work with all of you, and look forward to continuing this relationship in pursuit of educational opportunity and excellence for all of our students.
