Several juniors and seniors will be taking the ISTEP test **during the week of November 26**. As a re-tester, they may need to take both sections of ISTEP (English and Math) or just one section, depending on their success with the test previously.

We will be communicating with those students who need to test, so they know exactly what test(s) they need to take, but wanted parents to be aware of the testing dates as well. Please help ensure your students are in attendance at school this week and encourage them to do their best work; ISTEP is a graduation requirement within Indiana state statute. ## **HNHS Special Services Department Overview**

The goal of the HNHS Special Services Department is to support all students with IEPs in their least restrictive environment. This is the classroom setting that allows students to be with non disabled peers to the maximum extent appropriate. Special Services teachers provide students with this in a variety of ways to promote inclusion.

Team teachers work with classroom teachers to provide intentional instructional interventions to support academic growth to students with IEP's and those without. The team-teaching model allows for there to be two instructors in the classroom at a time and provide an opportunity for students with IEP's to remain in a regular classroom. Another level of support that is beneficial to some students with higher needs is being paired with a peer tutor or paraprofessional. Paraprofessional and peer tutors are not only

In the HNHS Special Services Department we not only strive to support all students with IEP's in the academic classroom but to also instill real world skills in our students. At HNHS we have team teachers who work with classroom teachers to provide intentional instructional interventions to support academic growth to students with IEP's and to those without. Students with higher needs have the opportunity to work with a peer-tutor while attending HNHS. This

relationship creates a positive experience with both the student and peer. In the upcoming months we will begin preparing for the ISTEP and finals and making sure our students receive all the accommodations needed to be successful and out lined in their IEP.
